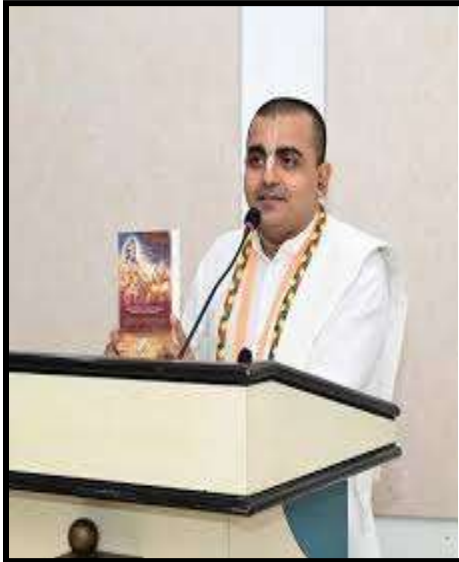

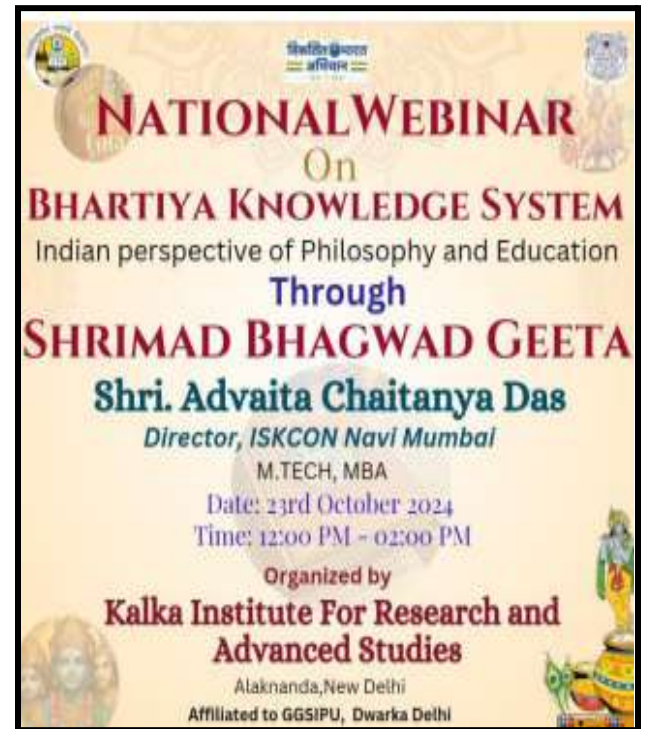

Glimpses of Different Childhood in India (22/10/2024)**



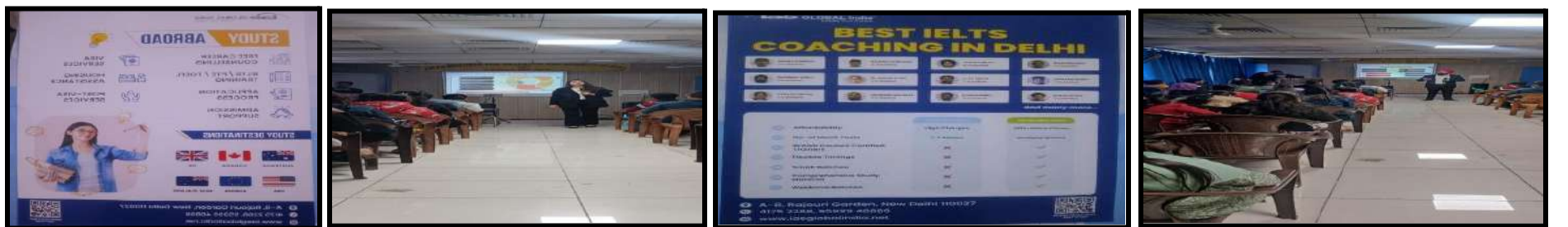

**Workshop on Career Counselling (16/02/2024)**



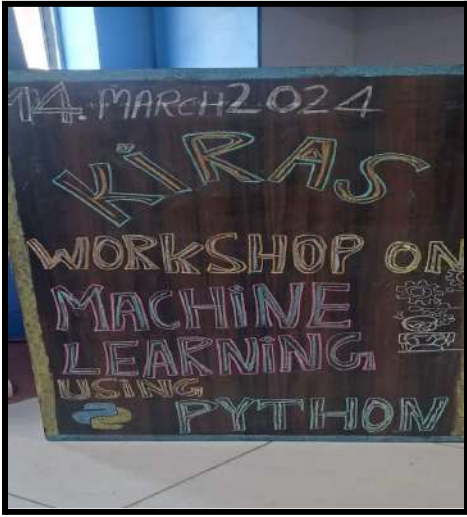

**National Conference on "Emotional & Mental Well Being in the Era of Digitalization through Indian knowledge System" (18.01.2025)**

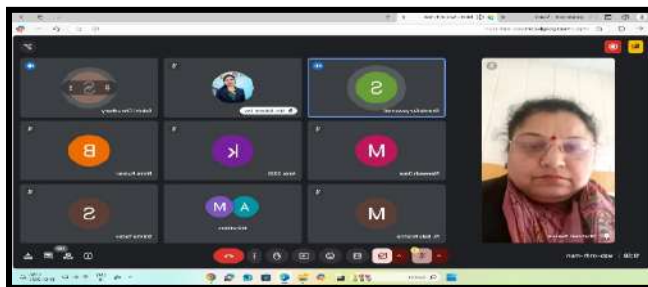

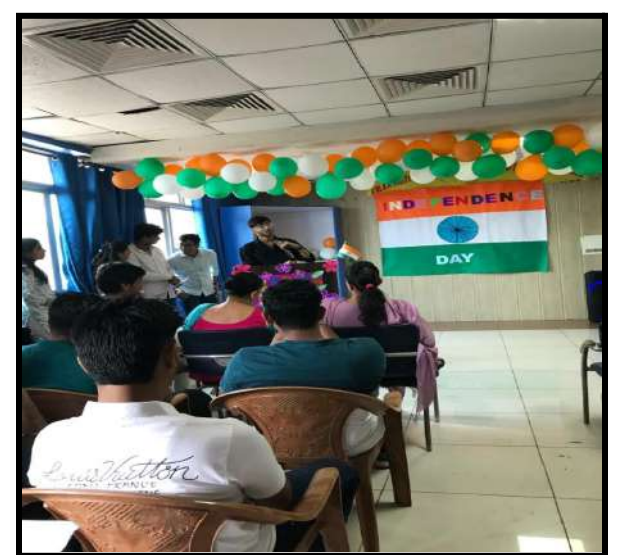
